1. Clean out your air filters!

Replacing your air filter improves the air quality, increasing your family's safety and comfort. It also ensures your system is working as efficiently as possible, saving energy and lowering monthly utility costs.

2. Change the direction of your ceiling fans.

Adjusting the direction of your fans' rotation counterclockwise produces a downdraft that pushes cool air into the spaces below, which circulates cool air without having to touch the thermostat.

3. Clean your window and door tracks.

When cleaning the glass in your doors and windows, check the screens and tracks. If dirt has collected, your windows may not seal properly, which can let warm air enter your air-conditioned space, wasting energy.

4. Check your refrigerator coils.

Dirty coils force the fridge to work harder to keep food inside cold, which drives up your electricity bill.

5. Clean your clothes dryer.

Cleaning your dryer's vent and ductwork can improve its performance by up to 70%, which helps it work faster and use less energy.
